- **Functionality Cookies:** Remember preferences set by you (such as cookie consent choices) to personalize your experience on return visits.

Managing and Disabling Cookies in Common Browsers

You can control or block cookies by adjusting your internet browser settings. Please note that restricting essential cookies may impact certain website features (such as online forms or ticket bookings).

Google Chrome	Go to Settings > Privacy and security > Third-party cookies (or Site Settings). Select your preferred level of blocking.
Apple Safari (macOS)	Open Safari, choose Settings (or Preferences) > Privacy, and select Block all cookies or enable cross-site tracking protections.
Apple Safari (iOS)	Go to Settings > Safari on your device and toggle on Block All Cookies or adjust tracking controls.
Microsoft Edge	Go to Settings > Cookies and site permissions > Manage and delete cookies and site data.
Mozilla Firefox	Go to Settings > Privacy & Security. Under Enhanced Tracking Protection, choose Standard, Strict, or Custom.
